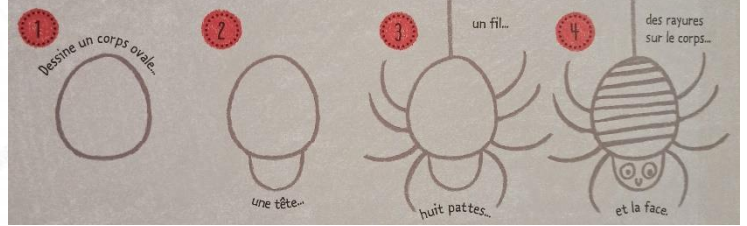
Cette production est très libre et peut être réalisée à 4, 6, 8 ou + mains.

Pour vous aider, quelques modèles d'araignées, de toiles d'araignée, d'éléphants sont proposés.





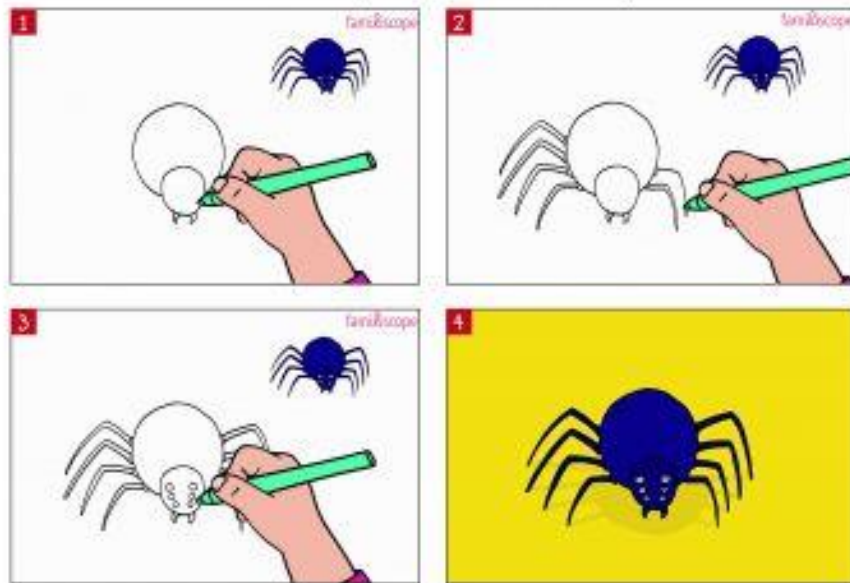

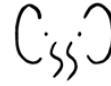

Begin with two dots and two S-shaped squiggles.

Draw two large C shapes for the ears.

Connect the ears with a curved line at the top, and two lines below.

4



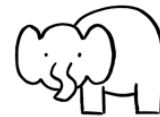
Now a big upside-down J-shaped line for the body.

5



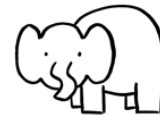
Write two uppercase L's for legs.

Draw a straight line for the front leg, and a connecting curved line.

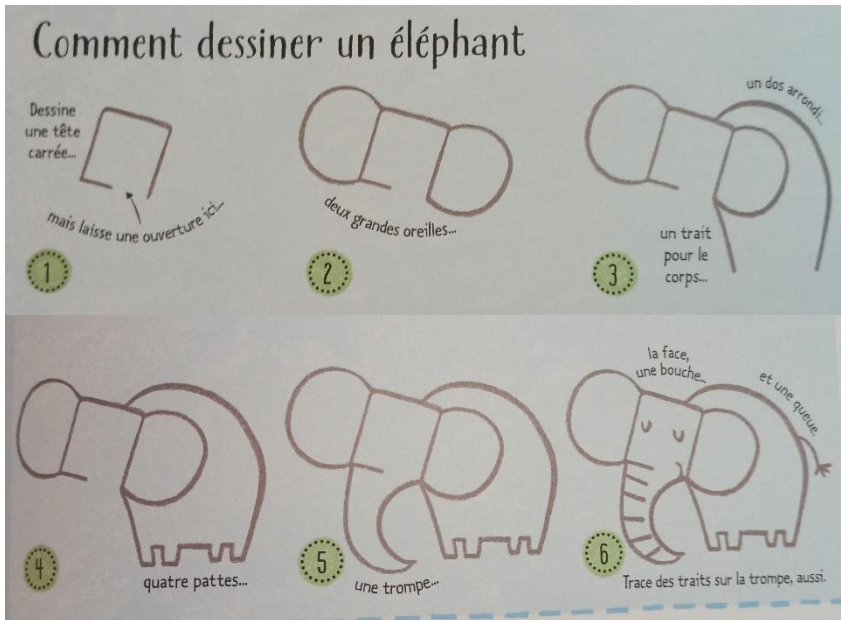


Two more smaller L's for the other legs.

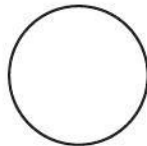


Add a smile and a squiggly tail and you're done!

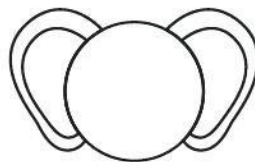
